Introduction

As part of Al Sakan Association's commitment to environmental sustainability and supporting productive families, a soap recycling initiative was implemented. The objective of this initiative was to collect partially used hotel soap bars, recycle them, and redistribute them for reuse, contributing to both environmental preservation and social impact.



Participating Hotels

Soap quantities were collected from the following hotels:

Collection Process

Prior coordination was made with each hotel separately to collect the available soap quantities. The soap was collected from each hotel on different scheduled days, and the process was carried out in an organized and smooth manner, facilitating the preparation of the soap for recycling and distribution to the beneficiary families.





Sorting and Packaging

After collection, the soap bars underwent the following process:

- Sorting and quality inspection
- Preparation for recycling and remanufacturing
- Organized packaging into designated boxes for distribution







Recycling and Redistribution

The packaged soap was distributed to several productive families to be reused in manufacturing new soap products.

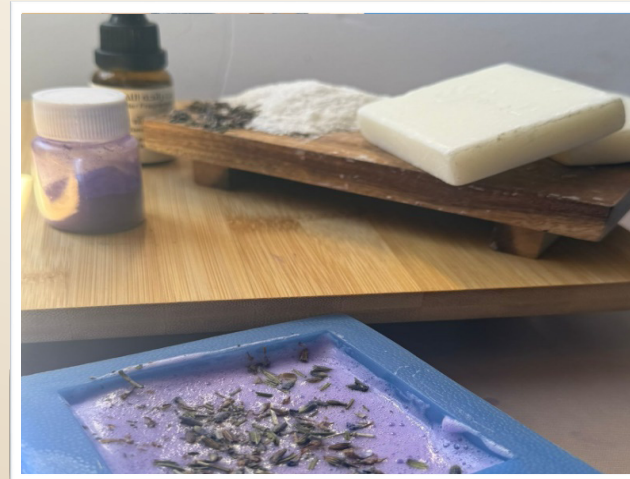
Among the beneficiaries was:
